Monday June 8: Tour up the Magnificent Columbia River Gorge – Tentative Schedule



Following the Full Conference Breakfast Buffet served in the Heritage Ballroom at The Hilton Hotel, our motor coach will depart at 9:00am, taking us on a ride up the historic Columbia River Gorge. Our first stop just East of Troutdale is Multnomah Falls: the tallest waterfall in the State of Oregon. It is credited as the second tallest year-round waterfall in the United States with over a 620-foot vertical drop. A foot trail leads to Benson Footbridge, a 45-foot (14 m)-long footbridge that allows visitors to cross 105 feet (32 m) above the lower cascade. Wander through the Multnomah Falls store and gift shop to purchase souvenirs and books about the historic Oregon Trail. After we visit The Falls, we will head up-river to Hood River to explore the downtown shops featuring a variety of local offerings. Then, off to the Riverside Restaurant for lunch to get a close-up view of the mighty Columbia River. After lunch, a stop for



wine tasting at the local favorite, Mt. Hood Vineyards, Winery and Tasting Room. Then we will travel back to Vancouver, returning to the hotel by 4:00pm.
