- Full time employee of a Pulp and Paper Products Industry end-user (Pulp, Paper, Board, Tissue, etc.) or consulting engineer working in support of clients in the industry.
- Less than 5 years of experience in the Industry.
- First Time IEEE PPIC Conference attendee.
- Able to participate in the entirety of the conference.
- IEEE/IAS will reimburse either the employee or company for the documented travel costs of airfare, other transportation and meals up to a maximum of \$1,000 per young engineering professional.
- Conference Registration and IEEE Membership will be refunded after you attend the Conference. If you are unable to attend after registering, normal cancellation policy will be in effect.
- Open to North American applicants only.
